The approval is subject to fulfilment of specific conditions as enlisted in Annexure-I and general conditions as enlisted in Annexure-II.

The Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall not announce admissions directly, under any circumstances and shall not do so in view of the Acquisition Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 30.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgment dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP (C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Usha Krishnamurthy and others v/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements.

In the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of any of the conditions, guidelines, norms, etc. decisions of recognition or recognition without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions. AICTE may inspect the institution at any time it may deem fit to note progress.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the address above in this regard to the Western Regional Committee of the AICTE under intimation to this office.

SHORT COMING TO BE FULFILLED.

(I) BUILDING:

1. The number of classrooms, Halls provided for academic purposes are totally short and requires addition as per AICTE's Norms.

(II) FACULTY:

1. It is observed that the present teaching faculty are engaged on adhoc/temporary basis, which should be regularised with permanent faculty members.
2. Additional teaching & technical supporting staff should be recruited to make it with the AICTE Norms within one year.
3. The regular principal should be appointed with qualification and good experience.

(III) EQUIPMENTS:

1. The total investment on Equipments for the courses provided is observed to be inadequate (90%). An additional investment is required to be provided immediately and confirmed provide the Equipments as required for the course.
2. The number of sets of Equipments provided for the courses is less than requirements for the existing batch size and hence additional set of Equipments are required to be provided immediately and confirmed.

(IV) LABORATORIES:

1. The overall size of the laboratories provided is observed to be inadequate and does not meet the minimum norms of the AICTE. Hence additional laboratory space should be provided immediately and confirmed.

### ANNEXURE II

#### General Conditions

1. No new course(s) shall be started or an ongoing course(s) shall be discontinued without the prior approval of the AICTE.
2. The intake capacity in any of the approved course(s) shall not be increased or varied without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. Adequate funds shall be available with the institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, from time to time.
4. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
5. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
6. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
7. Admissions shall be made according to the regulations and directions of the AICTE for such admissions in the respective technical institution or university. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc. shall be followed by the Institution.
8. Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
9. Institution shall maintain records and books/bf accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
10. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.
11. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
12. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
13. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

#### Additional Conditions for Pvt. and Grant-in-Aid technical institutions :

14. The Governing Body of the institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.
15. The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
16. The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
17. The institution should create an Endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and the concerned State Authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by the State Govt./UT or Rs. 10 lakhs, whichever is more.
