






Minutes of Meeting

The program was started with floral tributes, Buddha Vandana and introduction of the keynote speaker, Mr. Mallikarjun Borrigidde.

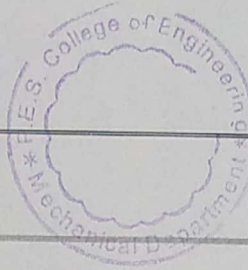
