Later vote of thanks was presented by Mr. Syed Mustakim (final Year, Mechanical Student), which was followed by National Anthem.

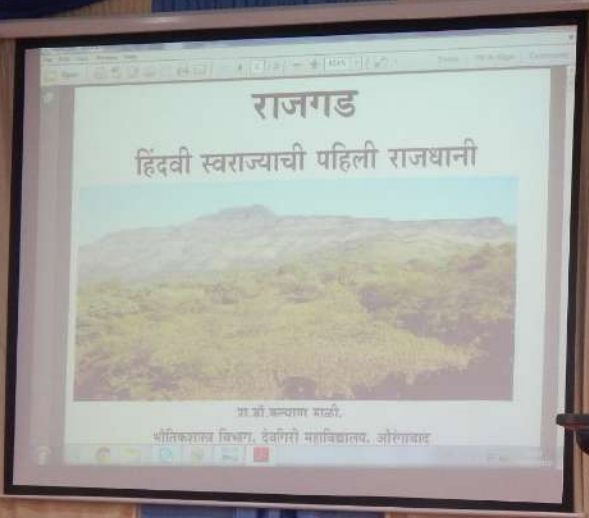
